ACTION

1. Special Projects

The Director's Office requested names of any Division 6 staff members working on special projects this summer. It was concluded we have none.

Space

SDC and Boeing have expressed a desire to send representatives to work with Group 61 on the preparation of the BOMARC B specs. This would involve 8 to 10, maybe as many as 16 people for whom we have no immediately available accommodations.

Proctor will investigate space in the SDC buildings and the Field Station.

3. Air Traffic Control

Israel reported the CHARM program approximately 80% complete. September 1 still looks like the ops date. WWI time is tight, but reliability good. Relationships with ADSID and AMB are good. A general discussion of Mode III operation was held.

4. SAGE II Computers

Lincoln should provide some means of following the development of the specifications for the IBM transistorized computers and not wait for the completed specs to be submitted for approval. It was agreed that this is important and that the appointment of a few people, probably in Group 68, as a committee to monitor the IBM effort seems the best approach.

5. ESS Gap Fillers

The geographical location of the present ESS Gap Fillers is not realistic and does not permit very meaningful tests. We should not deactivate any of the sites at present. We will investigate the possibility of tying in one or more ADC sites to permit more realistic tests.
